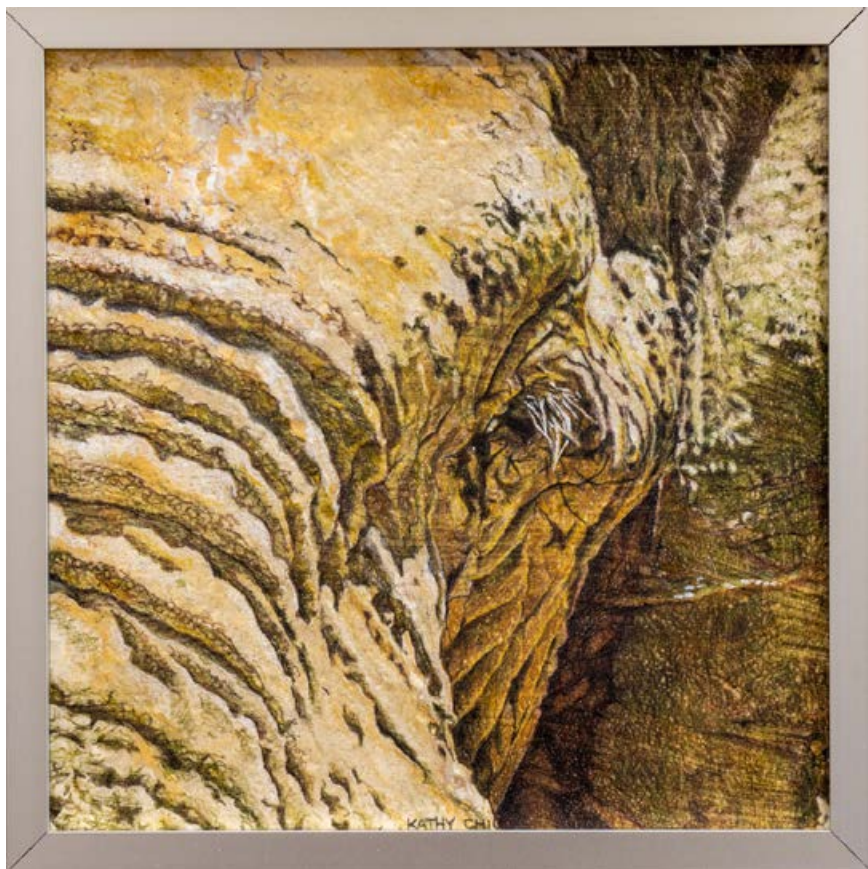

# Jolene Schafer

## Biography and Artist's Statement

**Nature Illustration Certificate Recipient, Spring 2022**

Nature is a companion that grounds me wherever I land in the world. The plants and animals of the Sonoran desert have inspired my current artwork, behaving both as models and desert ambassadors. I create masks that invite a viewer to see the world through another animal's eyes. My two-dimensional works document imaginary creatures and present them as additions to nature's creative catalog.



My masks are sculpted from lightweight materials to function both on a wall and as wearable art. My design process scales a subject's features to human facial proportions. The mask then becomes an opportunity for a person to imagine themselves as another creature. In my two-dimensional work I combine plant, insect and animal

structures using drawing media and watercolor to develop believable details based on observation. The resulting creatures have the potential to surprise a viewer, who may be expecting to digest a traditional piece of art.

By creating work that encourages people to engage with their imagination, I want to wake them up! I hope that my art will inspire curiosity, promote conservation and celebrate the infinite variety of biological forms.

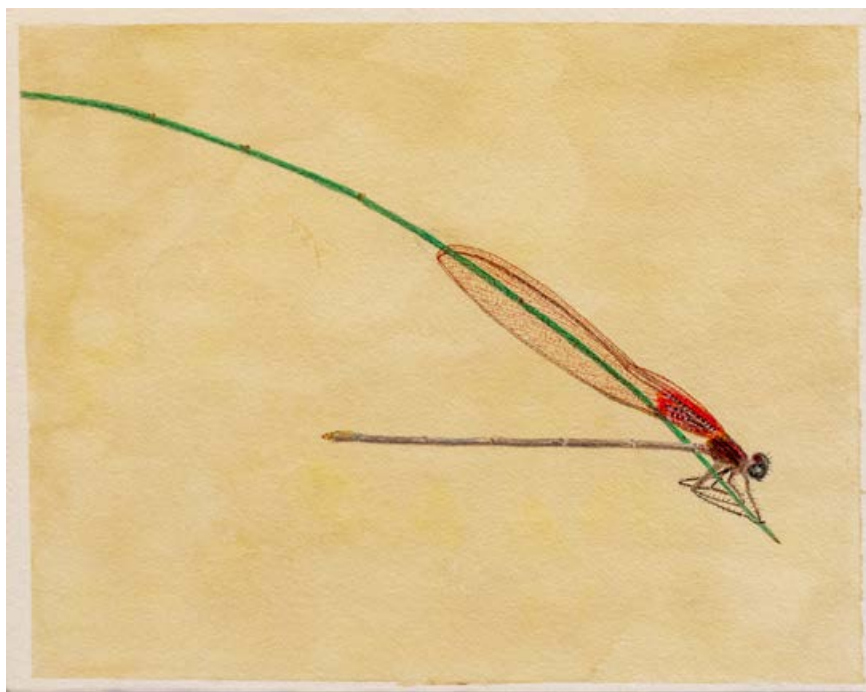

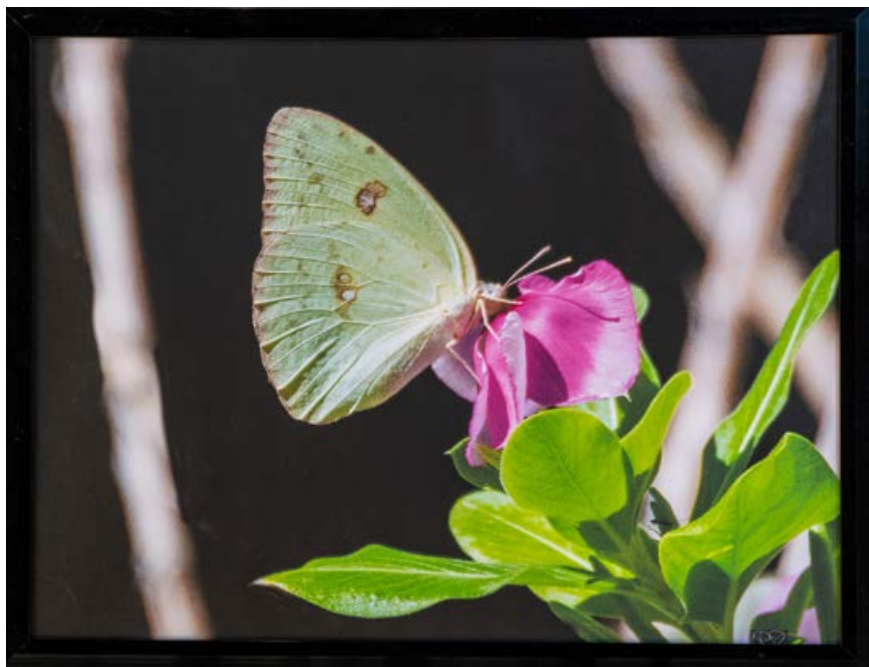

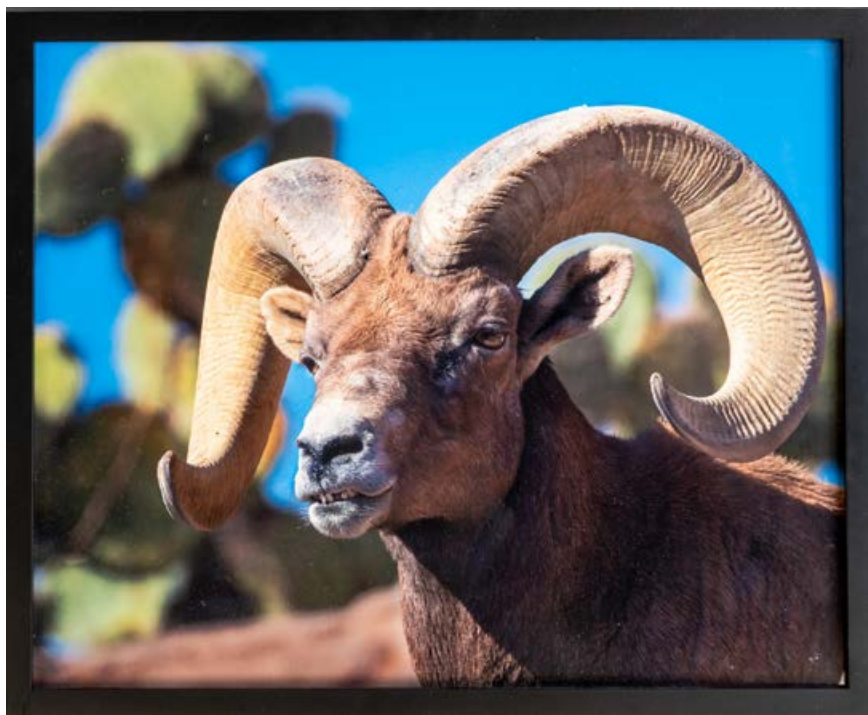
